

## **Last Minute Details Concerning the Via Crucis Telecast**

---

- The Eurovision broadcast and international feeds via Intelsat and “PanAmSat” will begin at **19:10** GMT (21:10 Rome time) with the customary Eurovision logo appearing right after the video goes to black. The ceremony starts at 19:15 GMT (21:15 Rome time).
- **25 minutes of extra broadcast time have been added given that the ceremony may go over the pre-scheduled time. Therefore, Eurovision and international satellite feeds are now booked until 21:15 GMT (23:15 Rome time).**
- If the ceremony ends before 21:15 GMT, the international feeds will be stopped **FIVE** minutes after the Pope has left. Camera work will consist of wide shots of the Colosseum and crowds during this time.
- At the conclusion, the Pope may give a brief ad lib address before imparting his Apostolic Blessing.
